



## **D3 Class Series FAQ's**

### **What is the D3 Class Series?**

D3 stands for **Deep Dive Discovery** and is for students whose schedules allow for them to attend the full series of classes within the D3 Series selected. Style, level and duration of D3 classes offered will change from session to session, based on instructors, schedules and other fun factors!

### **How much are D3 Classes?**

Pricing for D3 classes will align with Drop In class package rates, offering a sliding scale, but vary depending on the length of the class series.

### **When are payments due?**

If paying in full, payment is due on the date of purchase. When selecting a plan, some plans offer options to split payments into 2 or 4 payments. The first payment is due on the date of purchase and remaining payments are due on the 5<sup>th</sup> of the next consecutive month(s). Please check with the Front Desk for D3 series that are a month or shorter. **IF YOU ARE PAYING IN MULTIPLE INSTALLMENTS, YOU MUST COMPLETE REGISTRATION WITH THE FRONT DESK.**

### **Are there payment plans and options for classes in the D3 Series?**

Yes! All guidelines and due dates for payments, sliding scale options, and Community Exchange Volunteer Hours (CEV Hours) will remain the same.

### **Are there CEV hour requirements for D3 Classes?**

If you've elected to pay less than the full price, you will be required to complete CEV hours. The number of hours due is listed beneath each payment option. For more information on CEV hours, please see the CEV Hours FAQ's sheet.

### **If I purchase a D3 Class, when does it expire?**

The expiration date for D3 classes will expire at the end of that class series. For example, if a series goes from 7/10-7/20, the expiration date is 7/20. Talk to the front desk about class absences and options.

### **What if I miss a D3 class?**

If you are unable to attend a D3 class in the series you purchased, you can make up the absence with any one of Keshet's Ongoing Drop In classes, appropriate for your age and level. You may not make up the absence with a different D3 series/class. Talk to the front desk about making up a class.
