- *Please bring your costume to the rehearsal, if you have more than one costume please have it clearly labeled in a bag.*
- *If you need assistance in providing a costume please fill out the Costume slip at the Front Desk. A \$10 fully refundable costume deposit is required from each dancer borrowing a costume from Keshet. Deposit will be refunded upon return of all borrowed costume pieces to Keshet. Please indicate what costume piece(s) you need to borrow and what class you*

are performing in.. If you have any questions about costumes, please contact Diana MacNeil, costumes@KeshetArts.org Deposits must be in the form of cash or check.

- **Performances:** All performances and tech/dress rehearsals will happen at the Keshet Center for the Arts Black Box Theater.
- **Scent-Free Dressing Rooms:** Please refrain from wearing scented personal care products such as cologne, perfume, aftershave lotions, scented lotions, and/or similar products.
- **Healthy Snacks:** As the dancers will be working hard during rehearsals and performances, please bring healthy snacks, and a water bottle. A microwave will be available to the dancers, and periodic breaks will be provided. Consider bringing a snack to share with the rest of the cast.
